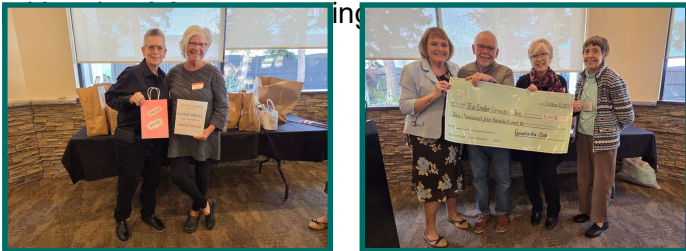

Rush Henrietta Area Food Terminal. They are dedicated to helping families with children and senior citizens through food distributions.

Church of the Incarnation-Eastern Service Workers Association. This is an outreach program providing holiday food for families and Christmas gifts for children.

Lakeview Community Pantry. They have expanded their food pantry to offer help and security to individuals and families along with special food for the holidays.

St. Peter's Kitchen shares hope and fights hunger in downtown Rochester. During the holidays they also provide special meals for all and toys for the children.

Blessed Sacrament Supper Program. Every week they feed 450 individuals a warm, nutritious meal within their safe and hospitable environment. They provide special holiday meals and give bags filled with necessities.
